SCRIPT CONTEST RULES SKYLINE BENIDORM FILM FESTIVAL

The headquarters of the Skyline Benidorm Film Festival is located at the following address: Plaza de S.S.M.M. Los Reyes de España 1, Benidorm (Alicante-Spain) and its official website www.skylinefest.es offers detailed information in order to contact.

Through a cultural project with a future projection, Skyline Benidorm Film Festival aims to promote, disseminate, professionalize and enhance short-form cinema.

ARTICLE 1. DATES

The celebration of the 7th edition of the Skyline Benidorm Film Festival will take place in the city of Benidorm, Spain, between March 25th to April 1st, 2023.

ARTICLE 2. REQUIREMENTS

The contest is open to all fiction, animation or documentary short film scripts, written in Spanish or Valencian.

The theme of the scripts will be free, original or literary adaptations, with a maximum of 20 pages (counting cover) and that have not been filmed before the start of the festival.

By participating in this contest, the authors acknowledge that they are in possession of 100% of the copyright of the submitted works.

ARTICLE 3. REGISTRATION

Each author may submit a maximum of three scripts.

The registration fee is 12€ per script. In the event that an author wants to register several works, the fee for the second script will be 10€ and for the third (if any) 8€. Payment will be made through Paypal to the account: director@skylinefest.es

The registration period will open from December 12th, 2022, and will remain open until January 31st, 2023.

The documentation will be sent to: guion@skylinefest.es as follows:

- Script in .pdf format where the author's name does **NOT** appear.
- Courier typography, size 12.
- Separate document with the full name of the author, photocopy of the ID, contact telephone, email and current address.
- Screenshot of the payment through Paypal.

ARTICLE 4. AWARDS

The award for the best short film script consists in 1,000€ and trophy.

The awards will be paid by bank transfer to the legal person who made the registration, being subject to the legal withholdings established by current Spanish law.

The trophies and awards will be presented at the final gala to the scriptwriter or representative. The organization will not be responsible for the shipping costs of the trophies of those not attending the festival.

ARTICLE 5. SELECTION OF THE FINALIST SCRIPTS

The selection of the finalists will be strictly confidential between the festival management and the representatives of each of the selected scripts, until the festival decides to announce it officially.

The finalist scripts will be published on the festival's website until the next edition is held, giving the opportunity to potential producers who are interested in reading them.

In case that any of the winners or finalists do not want their scripts to be in the public domain, it will not be uploaded to the festival's website.

ARTICLE 6. JURY

The jury will be made up of professionals from the film industry and will be in charge of deciding the finalist scripts and awarding the prizes.

The jury may declare any of the prizes void if it deems it appropriate, as well as award an honorific mention without financial prize.

The decisions of the jury will be final.

ARTICLE 7. INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY

The author or owner will maintain their intellectual rights and it will be their competence both that they are not subject to any legal responsibility, and that there are no rights to third parties.

This contest is governed by the provisions of Law 38/2003, of November 17, General Subsidies, by Royal Decree 887/2006, of July 21, which regulates the Regulations of the General Subsidies Law and what is established in the execution rules of the Benidorm City Council budget for 2023. People who are involved in any of the causes of prohibition to receive subsidies contained in article 13 of the General Subsidies Law will not be able to participate. The data of the participants will be collected and processed in accordance with Law 15/1999, of December 13, on the Protection of Personal Data.

All documentation received will become part of the festival's archive.

ARTICLE 8. ACCEPTANCE OF THE RULES

The submission to the festival implies the acceptance of these rules.

Any question not foreseen in the rules will be resolved by the organization of the festival. These rules are subject to possible modifications for reasons beyond the control of the organization.
